

PM 10,000 Warranty

For 90 days after the date of delivery to the carrier, Eye Communication Systems, Inc. warrants to the dealer that the product will be free from defects in material of such workmanship, and Eye Com Systems, Inc. liability solely to the replacement of such defective parts (1) which are returned, shipping and handling charges prepaid by the dealer to Eye Com Systems, Inc. (2) which are proven to be defective upon Eye Com Systems, Inc. inspection. The dealer's costs of labor to inspect and remove defective parts and to install replacement parts, shall be borne solely by dealer and shall not be reimbursable by Eye Com Systems, Inc. Defective parts shall become the property of Eye Com Systems, Inc. and must be shipped to Eye Com Systems, Inc. within 30 days after delivery of replacement part(s) to the carrier.

THE WARRANTIES CONTAINED IN THIS AGREEMENT ARE IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING ANY REGARDING MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, RELATING TO THE USE OR PERFORMANCE OF THE PRODUCTS. EYE COM SYSTEMS, INC. WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE (UNLESS CAUSED SOLELY BY EYE COM SYSTEMS, INC NEGLIGENCE) LOSS OF PROFIT OR OTHER INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF THE USE OR INABILITY TO USE THE PRODUCTS. Nor does this warranty extend to any product which has been (a) subject to misuse, neglect or accident, or (b) repaired or altered by other than service representatives qualified by Eye Com Systems, Inc. Consumables

The replacement schedule located in the service manual for the Eye Com Reader/Printer 9000 indicates the consumable parts. The replacement schedule for each consumable part is the estimated expected life of each part. However, some parts may last longer or less than the amount indicated in the replacement schedule for that part depending on certain variables. The variables which affect the life expectancy of each consumable part is machine usage (whether machine is being used regularly and volume of operation per month), length of time, environment, and whether machine is being serviced properly, such as routine preventive maintenance (PM). The estimated expected life of each consumable part mentioned in each service manual should be used as a guide for each dealer when ordering parts. Therefore, Eye Com Systems, Inc. does not warrant the expected life of each consumable part because of the above variables mentioned.
